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GROUP THERAPY

Occupational Therapy

Occupational therapy services allow children to participate in their daily activities or “occupations.” These activities may include feeding themselves, writing, or exploring their environment appropriately.

Physical Therapy

Physical therapy services allow children to restore or improve their mobility. These activities may include sitting, crawling and walking.

Speech-Language Therapy

Speech - language therapy services allow children to communicate more effectively and eat better. These activities may include talking, interacting socially, speaking more clearly or eating safely.

Developmental Play

The developmental play groups are led by a developmental therapist and focus on the children’s overall development including behavior, communication, socialization, motor skills and pre - academics / cognition.

Social Skills

The social skills groups are led by a speech language pathologist and focus on the children’s social interaction including taking turns, joining in conversations and staying on topic.

Handwriting Therapy

The handwriting groups are led by an occupational therapist and focus on the children’s handwriting including pencil grasp, letter formation and proper spacing.

Sensory Exploration

The sensory exploration groups are led by an occupational therapist and focus on the children’s ability to explore the environment through their senses and use that information appropriately. It is designed with children with sensory integration difficulties in mind.

Aquatic Therapy

During aquatic therapy, the therapist works with the child in water. The buoyancy of the water allows the child to practice movement in water that they may not be able to perform on land.
