**Antecedent:** Event that happened **right before the behavior**. Please be specific when documenting (e.g., told Johnny to do his worksheet, turned off the TV, told Emily that she couldn't have ice-cream, etc).

**Behavior:** Anything a person says or **does**, which occurs **right after the antecedent** (e.g., hitting, screaming, etc). Please be objective in your documentation (i.e., instead of saying "had a meltdown" document exactly what the behavior looked like- "fell to the floor, screamed and cried").

**Consequence:** Event that **immediately follows the behavior** that alters the likelihood of the behavior occurring again in the future (e.g., told Sara to go to time-out, reprimanded by saying "we don't hit kids", etc).
